- 1) Name of mentor and department

- 2) Project Title

- 3) Project Site/Location

- 4) Research Question (What do you/does your mentor want to know that will fill a gap in the current understanding about your topic?) Please watch the Education Scholarship Module on Asking Research Questions.

- 5) How do you plan to disseminate your project?

- 6) What will your role be?

7) Project Description (How do you plan to answer your question?)

- a) Participants (Who will be in your sample?)
- b) Recruitment (How will you ask participants to be involved?)
- c) Intervention or Procedures (What will you do? Is this an intervention, an innovation, a systematic review, or a descriptive study?)
- d) Data Collection Plan (Will you use surveys, quizzes, participant observations, interviews, focus groups, etc?)
- e) Data Analysis Plan (How will you determine whether or not your results are meaningful/significant?)
